Location

You can choose your study abroad destination from **Osaka**, **Kyoto**, **Wakayama**, **Tokyo**, or **Hokkaido**.



1. Spring Semester (April-)

- Enrollment: April
- School Period: 1 or 2 years
- Admission Period: August to October
- Exam Period: October to November



2. Fall Semester (October-)

- Enrollment: October
- School Period: 1 year and 6 months
- Admission Period: February to April
- Exam Period: April to May



Tuition fees for Japanese School

(Example) Breakdown and details of tuition for 1 year course

- Selection fee: 30,000 yen
- Enrollment fee: 50,000 yen (first time only)
- Tuition fee: 700,000 yen (One year)
- Supplies: 35,000 yen
- Others: 85,000 yen*

*Others, it includes facility and equipment fees, extracurricular activities, and insurance fees.

*For high school graduates

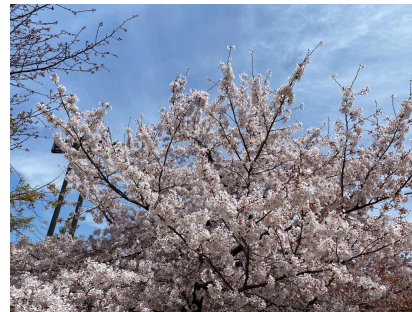
If you graduate a Japanese University, Junior college, or Vocational School after finishing Japanese school, you can earn a work visa

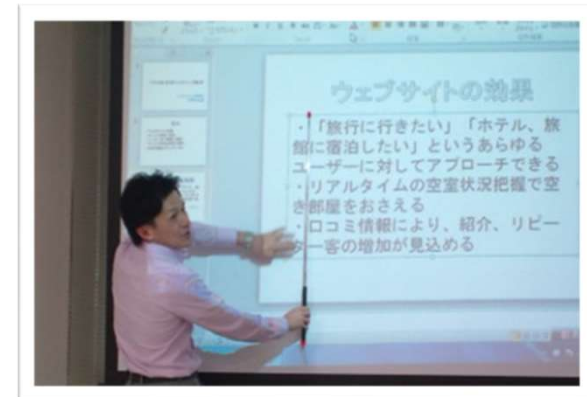

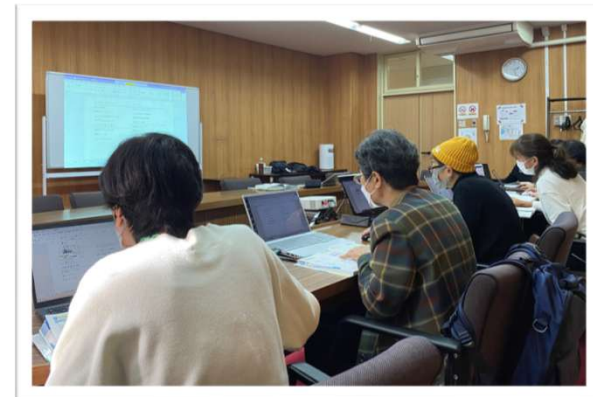
